Ruthven City Council Meeting April 22, 2020 - 6:30 PM

A regular council meeting of the Ruthven City Council was held April 22, 2020. In order to help stop the spread of the COVID-19 virus, this council meeting of the Ruthven City Council was held electronically. Chapter 21.8 of the Iowa Code does permit an electronic meeting where all members participate remotely when an in-person meeting is impossible or impractical, which is certainly true during this crisis. On March 19, 2020, Governor Reynolds issued a Proclamation of Disaster Emergency which included a suspension of Iowa laws that would prevent the use of electronic meetings or the limitation on the number of people present at an in-person meeting site. Therefore, Councilman Jay Schoning and City Employee Margaret Tatman were present at Ruthven City Hall at 1305 Gowrie St. The agenda and the City's social media had this message posted more than 24 hours in advance to give instructions on how others could participate in the meeting: Due to the COVID-19 crisis, the City of Ruthven will be holding this city council meeting electronically via a Zoom conference call. The Ruthven City Council, of the City of Ruthven, Iowa, met on the 22nd Day of April, 2020, at 6:30 PM, in regular session, in Council Chambers at City Hall, pursuant to law and to the rules of said council.

Mobile Food Vendors in town were discussed. Our current ordinance is sufficient. We will deal with food vendors one by one and use the current Transient Merchant code.

Kelly Evans of ISG Engineering spoke with Mayor and Council about the upcoming Water System Project. Met with city staff a few weeks ago. An estimated cost of an approximate \$2,300,000.00 for new well, upgrades to water system plant and for water system line upgrades. He divided the project into three (3) phases. With CDBG Grants that we can apply for and the 50% SRF Forgivable loan the city cost would come to \$900,000.00 if all grants and forgivable loans are awarded to the city. New well will be put just north of the softball field in city park property. The need to pass an Ordinance for Well control zones was discussed and will need to be done along the way.
